**"Socialisms and International Law in the Contemporary World"**, 15–16 September 2022, SNSPA, 2 Emanoil Bacaloglu St. Bucharest

This conference explores the role of state socialist intellectuals, experts and governments from East-Central Europe, Africa, Asia, and Latin America in developing international law in 20th and 21st centuries. We examine both contributions to the current international law, and competing ideas and initiatives which, although they did not achieve global consensus, constituted important disruptive moments in the history of international law. By looking at these different regions and doctrines, we contest linear and western-dominated histories. We examine how different state socialist ideologies, legal principles and Realpolitik affected contemporary international law frameworks. We consider these state socialist engagements in interaction with liberal and Western approaches, and we underline the divisions that existed between socialisms from different world regions and across the North-South divide.
