Horton creates creative opportunities, like the [Radical Reversal recording studio](#), for people in prison and his students at the University of New Haven in Connecticut. **Nowak** creates documentary writing experiences with the global working class (taxi drivers, domestic workers, street vendors, retail workers, and teachers) through PEN America's [Worker Writers School](#), which he founded, and for his students at Manhattanville College in NY.
