The Benjamin L. Hooks Institute for Social Change, at the University of Memphis is accepting nominations for its 2022 Hooks National Book Award. The annual award recognizes a non-fiction book that best furthers the understanding of the Civil Rights Movement and its legacy. Books focusing on past or current civil rights and social justice issues, leaders, policies, laws, etc. are eligible. To be considered for the 2022 award, books must have a first-published date in 2022. Revised editions of previously published books are not eligible. A panel of judges, representing various higher education disciplines, reviews the nominations and selects the winning book.

An award of \$1,000 is presented for the award in 2023 at the University of Memphis. The winner must attend the event to accept the award and present a lecture about the book.
