The Institute for Indology and Tibetology at LMU Munich invites applications for two positions: the first one as a **Lecturer of Sanskrit**, the second as a **Postdoctoral Researcher in the History of Art and Archeology of South Asia**.

1. Lecturer of Sanskrit

This is a full-time position as Lecturer of Sanskrit. The position is formally defined as a “Lehrkraft für besondere Aufgaben” (grade A 13) and it is meant to become permanent. If eligible, the post holder will become a public servant (Beamter). The deadline for applications is **21 December 2022**, and our new colleague is expected to start on **1 April 2023**.
