Call for papers, posters, artworks and artist-talks open until 31 January 2023

The fifth international conference Taboo - Transgression - Transcendence in Art & Science will take place September 27-29, 2023 in Valletta, hosted by the [Malta Society of Arts](#). Including theoretical and art practice presentations, TTT2023 continues to focus (a) on questions about the nature of the forbidden and aesthetics of liminality as expressed in art that uses or is inspired by technology and science, and (b) on providing uncensored space for creative transformation in the merging of science and art.

Submissions are welcome from all art and research fields and cutting-edge technology in arts-based research. Suggested, but not exclusive topics, are those associated with: Biopunk, hybridity, and aesthetics of mutation; Cyborg, augmentation, and body modification; Chemistry of the mind, natural healers, and mind enhancement; Biotechnology, DIY & DIWO, and biohacking; Ethology, human and nonhuman; Evolution, genetics, and plasticity; Post-gender, transgressive identities, and social models; Human sexual response, laws of attraction, and queer-eroticism; Parasitology, symbiosis, and microbiome; Biopolitics, displacement, and resistance; Pandemic, bioterror, and scientific trust; Witchcraft, gender narrative, and history of science; Rewilding, degradation, and restoration.
