The journal appears usually two times per year and encourages contributions of scholarly and creative nature which take advantage of the online format.

Glossen, located on a server at Dickinson College in Carlisle, PA, is an independent journal published by an international team of contributors and editors. **ISSN 1093-6025**

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Glossen is working on a relaunch of the journal while we feature the four volumes of the *Wende-Reader* and is therefore not currently accepting new articles for peer review. We do continue to feature an ongoing series "Recent Posts," which focuses on topical and current events, personal experiences, and other forms of intellectual communication.
