The lectureship aims to advance the field of study by presenting new and creative work by a senior scholar and interreligious practitioner.

The inaugural Silber-Obrecht Lecture, to be held from April 25-27, 2023 at Loyola University Maryland, will be delivered by [Francis X. Clooney, S.J.](#), a theologian at the Harvard Divinity School and a leader in the field of [interreligious studies](#).
