This project includes the development of a unique digital portal with exemplary writing on Kentucky women's history and culture that appeals to both scholars and a general audience of readers. We seek support for contributing local history essays and personal items from family keepsakes that show the wide scope of this history. In 2020 during the centennial celebrations for the passage of the 19th Amendment, we hope to serve as a clearing house for all the local and statewide events on this topic.
