- 5. Be sure to include your name, affiliation, phone number, and email address in your document. Creative art submission guidelines:
- 1. Creative art includes art displays, writing, drama, music and visual arts. If your work falls into one of the above categories, you are required to submit a 350-word description of your creative artwork.
- 2. If the Center has questions on the proposal, we will reach out to you via email.
- 3. You may submit your abstract in Word or PDF format.
- 4. Include your name, affiliation, phone number, and email address in your document.
