The Carol Gold Best Article Award is named for longtime member, activist and scholar, Carol Gold whose [life](#) and work exemplify the dual mission of the CCWH—to promote women’s history and to support women in the historical profession. Gold has written extensively on [early modern](#) European women’s history and has mentored and supported students and peers during her long career. The Carol Gold Best Article Award is a \$500 prize given to the best article published in a peer-reviewed journal in the year prior to the award year (so in 2017 for the 2018 award). Applicants must have achieved the rank of [Associate Professor](#) at the time of publication and applicants must be current members of the CCWH at the time of [application](#).
