All articles deemed appropriate for JMH are sent out anonymously for peer review by scholars who are experts in the author's particular field. We cannot accept or review articles that have been published elsewhere or are under consideration by any other journal or publisher. Each author will receive a copy of the issue in which the article appears.

The *Journal of Moravian History* is a peer-reviewed English language journal which publishes scholarly articles and reviews publications in all areas of the history of the Unitas Fratrum (Moravian Church, *Herrnhuter Brüdergemeine*). JMH also publishes research notes and original primary source materials relating to the Unitas Fratrum.
