In October 2019, the Royal Historical Society (RHS) released a “guidance paper” on [“Plan S and the History Journal Landscape.”](#)

Plan S is the initiative of 11 major research funders in Europe to require immediate access to articles. The new report is based on a survey of journal editors in the United Kingdom (see the Royal Historical Society's [news release](#)).
