PhD is required, either in history or in one of the exciting related interdisciplinary fields, as are strong language skills in their field of research. Advanced ABD will be considered, but the successful candidate must have PhD in hand by August, 2021. Teaching duties consist of three courses per semester, including introductory courses in East Asian history, major courses by specialty, as well as contributions to the Core Curriculum. Ability to teach one or more courses in Chinese history is preferred.
