- Submissions on all topics related to the Mid-Atlantic region or by oral historians in the Mid-Atlantic region are welcome.
- Conference registration fees will be as follows:

Individual, \$35 (includes one-year membership in OHMAR*)

Student, \$20 (includes one-year membership in OHMAR*)

Guest, \$10 (no membership included)
