As 2021 begins, the H-Early-America team welcomes two new book review editors. **Troy Bickham**, a Professor of History at Texas A&M University, has a trans-Atlantic perspective on early America and the wider Atlantic world, as well as extensive experience as an author, editor, and reviewer. His books include *Eating the Empire: Food and Society in Eighteenth-Century Britain* (2020) and *The Weight of Vengeance: The United States, the British Empire, and the War of 1812* (2012). **Patrick Luck**, an Assistant Professor of History at Florida Polytechnic University, also approaches early American history with an Atlantic twist; his research on the Lower Mississippi Valley bridges the Spanish colonial and American republican periods in the region. **Josh Jeffers**, who has edited book reviews for H-Early-America since the spring of 2017, will be stepping down to focus on other professional projects. Josh re-started the reviews program after H-Early-America's hiatus in the mid-2010s and has been instrumental in getting the list back on a firmer footing.
