We especially welcome papers that reflect on the Humanities in a Digital world, including but not limited to the following themes:

- Digital cultural heritage with a focus on both digitised and born digital documents / archives
- Digital scholarly editing
- Data visualization, information retrieval, statistical analysis, big data

- Digital Humanities projects presentations
- Digital Humanities books reviews

Beyond the above mentioned, we invite submissions of abstracts on and related to any aspect of Digital Humanities: practical experimentation, theorising, cross- and multidisciplinary work, and new and relevant developments.
